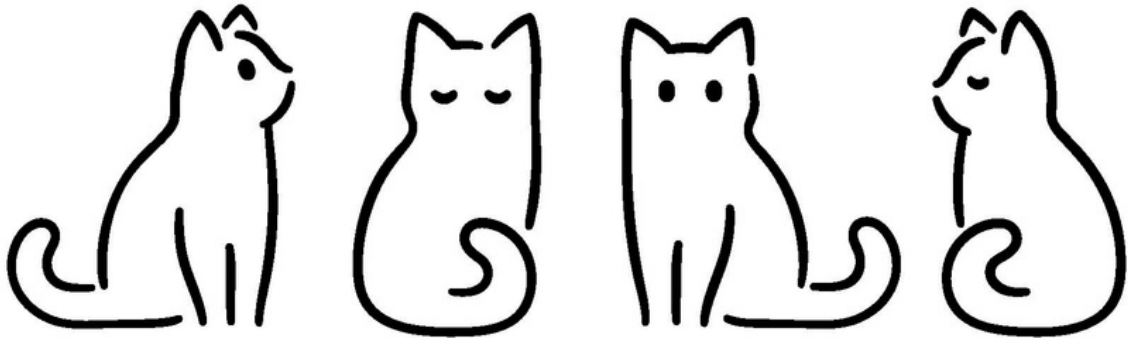


# NETWORKING
